### **Premium Information**

Because the premium rate is based on your attained age, the premium will increase each year as you age. This annual premium change will occur on the first policy renewal date which coincides with or follows the policy anniversary date. A premium change for any other reason can only be made if we make the same change to all policies using this form issued in the same state to persons of the same classification. In no event will the premium rate increase more often than once during any 12-month period.

### **Risk Class Rating**

If, according to our underwriting standards, you are overweight or underweight for your height, you will be considered to be a greater insurable risk. In such a case, your premium will be priced either as Class I – 10% or Class II – 20% higher than the rates illustrated, based on your Body Mass Index (BMI) reading. Risk class rating will not be applicable when you apply for coverage during an open enrollment or guaranteed issue period.

### **Household Premium Discount**

You are eligible for a household premium discount if you reside with at least one, but not more than three, other adults. Your policy's household premium discount will be removed if the other adults no longer resides with you (other than in the case of their death).

The discounted premium will be priced 12% lower than the rates illustrated.
